CLASSES BEGIN MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 9TH, 2024.

EMAIL

ALL updates, reminders, as well as your Spring Newsletter with Recital Guidelines will be sent via email.

*If you do not receive an email by the end of the first week of classes, please notify the studio via email at info@centrestagedance.com to ensure that we have your correct email address. Also check your junk mail! If our emails are going to your junk mail, add us as a "favorite" on a PC (not from a phone, iPad, or laptop) and it should resolve this. *

DANCE ATTIRE REQUIREMENTS

You will also receive the guidelines outlining the appropriate attire and footwear required to participate in dance class. Street clothes such as jean shorts, and jeans do not allow for freedom of movement. These requirements are **mandatory** to enable the teacher to detect and correct students' body alignment. Please follow our guidelines as they are designed for the safety of our students. Please make sure to label both shoes and clothing with the student's name.

BALLET CLASS ATTIRE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!

DANCE ETIQUETTE & BEHAVIOR

We look forward to creating a positive atmosphere for all students attending the studio. It is our responsibility to show appropriate and respectful behavior towards the students and in turn, we feel the students should be respectful and show appropriate behavior towards all teachers, reception staff, and other students while on the premises. If any problems occur, parents will be contacted, and a solution will be discussed.

BULLYING & VANDALISM

We have zero tolerance towards any type of bullying, whether physical or emotional. In today's day and age, bullying is becoming a huge problem, and it will not be tolerated here at CentreStage Dance. Any students caught bullying risk being dismissed from the studio. Any students caught mistreating or vandalizing the premises will be dismissed from the studio.

THEFT

Any students caught stealing items from the studio (whether belonging to the studio or to other dancers) will be dismissed from the studio. Please leave your valuable items at home, as we want to minimize the risk. The studio and its faculty are not responsible for any lost or stolen articles. We understand that some valuables are brought to the studio such as iPods, cell phones, laptops, and wallets when the students come straight from school, but we would like to remind everyone to take such valuables into class with them.

ATTENDANCE & COMMITMENT

During each dance season, students work on a choreographed dance, which will be performed in the year-end recital. Students gain a great sense of pride and accomplishment through hard work and dedication. Our goal is to see each student improve his or her performance and technical skills throughout each year. A successful performance requires both attendance and commitment to dance classes; therefore, we ask that students attend their classes regularly. Re-enforcing the work each week goes a long way to increasing the student's self-esteem. Students missing 4 or more consecutive classes (without just cause) may, at the discretion of the teacher, be excluded from the year-end performance. Please remember dancing is a **TEAM EFFORT**, no different than any other sport and we all rely on each other to be there.

Please contact the studio via email or phone call if your child will be absent from class.

STUDENT PLACEMENT

Upon registration, you will receive a day and time for your child to attend dance class. Occasionally, a teacher will see a need to place a student into a class that is better suited to their age or individual abilities. During the months of September and October, the teacher may suggest to parents an alternative day and time for their child to attend class. Our goal is for the students to enjoy dancing and feel good about their accomplishments.

Please note: Studio schedules are subject to change.

EXAM CLASSES

Exam classes are recommended for the more advanced, serious, and dedicated students. Exams offer students an excellent opportunity to enhance their technical skills and achieve higher levels in dance. Please ask to see our detailed printout outlining this program.

COMPETITIVE CLASSES

In addition to our **Recreational** program, and our **Company** program, we also have our fantastic "**Competitive**" program! This exciting program is perfect for students (with at least 2 years of dance) and parents who would like to have some extra fun throughout the season and experience the competition scene on a smaller scale, with less of a time and financial commitment! HOLIDAYS AFFECTING SUNDAY, MONDAY, AND FRIDAY CLASSES

On **Tuesday, June 3rd, 2025**, we will be holding our annual "Make-Up Class Day" for students affected by holidays and statutory holidays. On this day, students can take an assortment of different classes.

Please note: Classes cancelled due to weather conditions beyond our control will not be rescheduled, but you may also attend the make-up class day.

FAMILY VIEWING

Family viewing week will be held **Monday, January 13th to Sunday, January 19th, 2025**. During this week, family members are invited to view their child's class. Parents bringing small children are asked to keep them seated during this time. We ask that during family viewing all cell phones and electronic devices be turned OFF.

One of our favorite weeks! Bring A Friend Week! This year our “Bring A Friend Week” will take place **Monday, March 10th to Sunday, March 16th, 2025.**

The conventions are intensive 2-to-3-day workshops offering classes in various disciplines from world-renowned choreographers. In June 2025, we will be holding our annual Dance Recitals at The ACT Theatre.

The students work very hard on their dances during the year, and the recital is a great way to bring the dance season to a close. Also, it gives the students an opportunity to learn the art of entertainment, which is another important part of dance. As the year end approaches, we all share in the enthusiasm and excitement. Seeing our dancers onstage in their costumes, celebrating their accomplishments, and sharing their excitement is why we do what we do! Each dance will perform in two of the five shows, and it is very important that dancers attend both performances. Like any other team activity, their teammates rely on them.

We would like to take this opportunity to sincerely thank all the friends, family, and parents for volunteering their time at our rehearsals, recitals, and community events. We cannot thank you enough for your support each and every year.

We would not be able to do it without you!

Please understand that we have set recital dates on rotation with other studios at The Act Theatre, and that we do not choose our dates from year to year.

COSTUMES

For the recital, the students will need a costume. We try very hard to keep the costumes reasonably priced and try to, if possible, keep costs to under \$100.00 (with tax included). Costumes may be purchased, or sewn by seamstresses, whichever proves to be the most economical.

COSTUME DEPOSIT - \$65.00 PER RECREATIONAL CLASS - DUE UPON REGISTRATION

This deposit will be due upon registration to ensure your child's spot in the class and the \$65.00 will be deducted from the total cost of the costume. The costume deposit must be paid before your child begins classes, and the balance will be due in the Spring upon completion.

Costumes WILL NOT be handed out until the final balance is paid, as well as ALL outstanding fees.

COSTUME DEPOSIT & REFUND POLICY

From September, through to November 1st, 2024, \$10.00 of the costume deposit will be withheld upon cancellation of classes to cover administrative fees. Costume Deposits will **NOT** be refunded after November 1st, 2024. Costumes started or completed at time of cancellation **must be paid for in full**. (For our company and competitive classes, the \$80.00 costume deposit is non-refundable after the first day of classes Monday, September 9th, 2024.)

Any costumes started or completed at the time of cancellation will have the balance owing due.

DANCE FEES

All monthly fees will be paid by Pre-Authorized Withdrawals. Payments will be debited from your accounts on the 1st and/or the 15th of each month from September through June. **We have based our monthly fee on your child receiving 34 classes per dance season. The 34 classes are multiplied by the cost per class, and then divided by 10 to arrange equal monthly payments.**

This way, your monthly fee remains the same all season. Depending on the year, your child may not have a class in June, but there will still be a monthly fee this month for classes received. If you have any further questions regarding this, please feel free to email or call the studio!

N.S.F. Fees: Our fees for all N.S.F. pre-authorized payments and cheques are \$25.00.
IMPORTANT - For all outstanding fees, each additional month that your account is in arrears, an additional \$10.00 will be charged to your account.

REGISTRATION FEE - \$55.00 (\$65.00 late registration fee as of September 1st)

Please note, if you come in to register prior to September 1st, but do not pay the registration fee until after September 1st, you will owe the \$65.00 late registration fee.

Your registration fee covers not only all registration costs, but as well as ensures that each student will receive an online HD quality media package of **ALL SHOWS!** You do not need to order your child's recital videos or take photos! You will automatically get them both! You will receive a link to download your videos, as well as professional photos of all shows (valued at well over \$200)!

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Students withdrawing permanently from class, upon receiving written cancellation via email, will have pre-authorized payments stopped, **with a full month's notice as of the 1st of each month.**

\$10.00 of the costume deposit will be withheld upon cancellation, for administrative fees.

Recreational Costume Deposits will not be refunded as of November 1st, 2024.

Competitive and Company Costume Deposits will not be refunded after September 9th, 2024.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING VIA EMAIL.

ONE MONTH'S NOTICE AS OF THE 1st OF EACH MONTH IS REQUIRED.

Telephone cancellations or handwritten notes will not be considered valid.

Effective May 1st each year, June monthly fees are non-refundable upon cancellation.

\$55.00 Registration Fee (or \$65.00 late registration fee, as of Friday, September 1st) is non-refundable
